I have left a voicemail for Sharon McGladdery to indicate that HEB hatcheries have had strong instructions since the 1990's not to use MG. A letter was recently re-issued by Brian Pearce to bring this to hatchery staff attention again. The only use that I am aware of in recent years is for Punt ledge chinook in the late 1990s where it was done under a CFIA emergency drug release and under veterinary prescription.
