**NOTICES OF MOTION FOR THE PRODUCTION OF PAPERS**

**P-37** — November 17, 2005 — Mr. Cummins (Delta—Richmond East) — That an Order of this House do issue for a copy of a letter dated August 27, 1981, from the President of CMHC, R.V. Hession, to the Deputy Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources (now Natural Resources), Mickey Cohen, warning that the department's energy conservation measures were a source of moisture induced damage in the exterior walls of newly constructed homes.

**P-38** — November 17, 2005 — Mr. Cummins (Delta—Richmond East) — That an Order of this House do issue for a copy of a letter dated September 29, 1981, to the President of CMHC, R. V. Hession, from the Deputy Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources (now Natural Resources), Mickey Cohen, expressing concern that CMHC has linked the department's energy conservation measures with moisture induced damage in the exterior walls of newly constructed homes.

**P-39** — November 17, 2005 — Mr. Cummins (Delta—Richmond East) — That an Order of this House do issue for copies of a CMHC document entitled, Moisture Induced Structural Damage in Housing: Terms of Reference for a Research Program, prepared for the Technical Research Division of CMHC by Peter A. Rowles and dated July 1981, that advised “there have been a number of reported cases of moisture induced structural damage in housing across Canada”.

**P-40** — November 17, 2005 — Mr. Cummins (Delta—Richmond East) — That an Order of this House do issue for copies of a 1981 CMHC management document entitled, Addendum to Management Submission for Moisture Induced Problems in Housing, that concluded “structural damage to NHA insured housing may lead to widespread defaults on mortgages.”

**P-41** — November 17, 2005 — Mr. Cummins (Delta—Richmond East) — That an Order of this House do issue for copies of a CMHC Memorandum to Management dated August 4, 1981, entitled, Moisture Induced Problems in Housing, that concluded “CMHC could be delinquent in not bringing aspects of the problem to the attention of others.”

**P-42** — November 17, 2005 — Mr. Cummins (Delta—Richmond East) — That an Order of this House do issue for copies of a letter dated November 13, 1981, from the President of CMHC, R.V. Hession, to the Deputy Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources (now Natural Resources), Mickey Cohen, asking him to “face up to the reality that energy conservation measures do, in fact, increase the hazard of moisture induced structural damage.”

**P-43** — November 17, 2005 — Mr. Cummins (Delta—Richmond East) — That an Order of the House do issue for copies of Moisture Induced Problems in NHA Housing – Summary Report, a report on “moisture troubled homes” prepared for the Research Division, Policy Development and Research Sector of CMHC by J.H. Poorten, dated October 1984.
